

Policy for reproduction and reuse of the READY model

The READY reference model has been developed with the specific purpose to be adapted (both in terms of language and of content) so that it can be used meaningfully by various education, training and lifelong learning stakeholders in their contexts. Because of this, the model is released with a Creative Commons licence CC-BY 4.0 that allows anyone to reproduce (copy and redistribute it in any medium or format) and reuse it (adapt, translate, remix, transform and build on it).

Adaptation of the content of the model

In case you want to change some parts of the model, you must:

- acknowledge the original source by stating that “READY has been developed by the European Training Foundation's (ETF) in the framework of the Creating New Learning (CNL) initiative.”
- fulfil the obligation not to distort the original meaning of the model and the non-liability of the ETF for any consequences stemming from the reuse.

In any case, you are not authorised to reuse the model in a manner calculated to deceive or to defraud and you should avoid implying or suggest in any way that the ETF endorses you or your use.

Translation of the model to new languages

In case you want to translate (some parts of) the model, you must:

- Acknowledge the original source as it is stated on the original document and, if possible, provide a link to it (i.e. <https://view.genial.ly/6243253217ac64001885c67e/guide-the-etfs-ready-model>)
- Indicate any changes or modifications (e.g. translation) made to the original document, their author(s) and responsible organisations and declare that the ETF is not responsible for the translation.

As an example to be included in a translated report, the following notice would constitute a proper attribution:

"First published in English by the European Training Foundation, 2022

(language) translation: (identification of the translator and/or responsible organisation), (year).

The ETF is not responsible for this translation and cannot be held liable for any consequence stemming from the reuse of the document. The copyright over this translation is owned by (responsible author(s) and/or organisation(s)) – (responsible author(s) and/or organisation(s)), (year of the translation)."

Please note that if you modify, adapt or translate the model, you are not authorised to maintain:

- The logos of the European Training Foundation.

- The front cover, inside cover and/or back cover pages of the original document as this could result in doubts in relation to the source of the translation;

In addition, the authorisation to reuse does not cover contents (e.g. images, graphs) subject to intellectual property rights of third parties. Any third-party content included in the original document is identified in the inside cover page and/or in the figure caption.

You are encouraged to share your translation under a public licence, following the spirit of open knowledge.
