



The second training on Online instructional material (open educational resources, e-books, LMS and web 2.0 tools) selection, usage, development and quality assurance, developed as Module 2 within the project [Supporting the policy and VET teachers practice related to the usage, design, development and upgrade of high quality instructional material \(including online publishing\)](#) took place in Pancevo, on June 18th and 19th 2016.

Teacher capacities for Web-based learning activities were strengthened through various activities related to development of learning objectives, designing online activities and preparation of e-learning materials through Moodle LMS. Moodle's key aspects were presented and practiced within a group of highly motivated teachers coming from both social and natural sciences. Training's participants also had the opportunity to learn more about open educational resources, online assessment and development of blended learning courses for their students. Teachers are looking forward to next steps in their professional development, as they start working on the first instructional materials within the e - learning setting. .
