Communication is very important but must be very simple and direct. One type of communication is Instant messaging. The advantage is that the students already know how it works. Instagram, Snapchat, Telegram, Signal, ... are certainly closer to young people than e-mails. We therefore need an application that enables us as teachers to communicate best with learners. The important thing is not to impose a new, unknown form of communication on learners. The necessary communication methods can be summarized as follows: single chat, group chat, live lessons.

In order to be able to use the above-mentioned communication methods optimally, a suitable application is required. The following aspects should be considered when selecting the application: free of charge or inexpensive, easy handling of the application, and platform independent (Windows, MacOS, Android, iOS).

Despite distance, it's school

Even though the handling of school applications is similar to the applications used in everyday life, the way of communication is different. Discipline and use of language, as used in class, also apply in virtual space. Therefore, rules must be defined. Respectful interaction with teachers and students must be at the top of this list of rules. Further rules can be as follows: daily review of new communication; fixed times for live lessons, "office hours" etc.

One tool to rule them all

If you use the free systems like Microsoft Teams (license A1), Google Classroom or Moodle, you will find a complete learning management environment. All important tasks of the teacher in the school area, from distributing and collecting tasks to sharing files and live lessons, are possible with Microsoft Teams on the one hand and on the other hand can be used low-threshold. But the most important thing, communication, comes first.

Slow but steady

If you have decided on a system, you should first look at the possibilities of synchronous communication. All of the above mentioned applications include exclusive direct (synchronous) communication with students. A slow, cautious but also comprehensible expansion of the functionality of the applications, which can also be used as a learning management system, leads to a higher acceptance by teachers and students.
