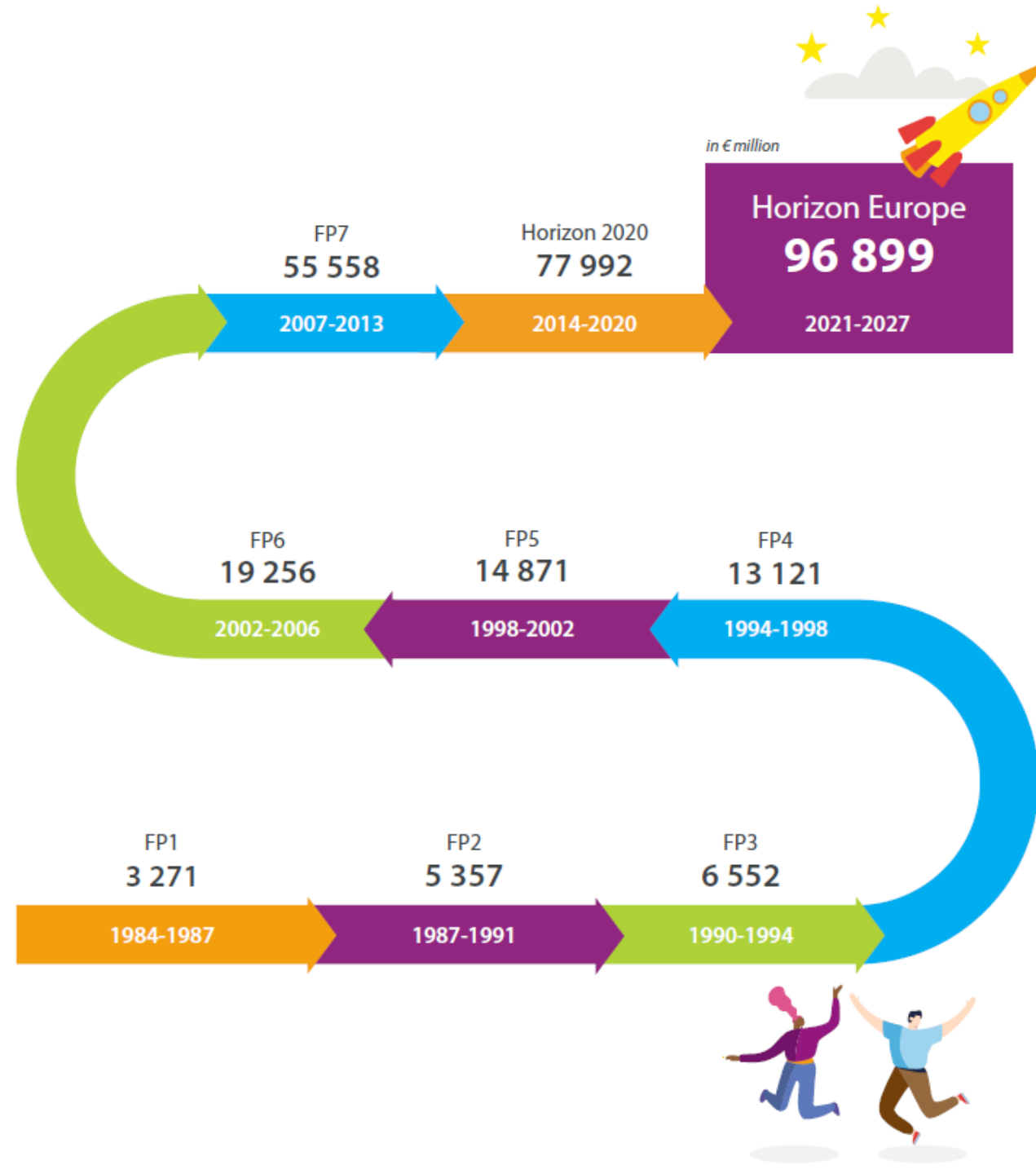

The main types of the HE projects

- **RIA (Research and Innovation Action)** - primarily consists of activities aiming to establish new knowledge and/or to explore the feasibility of a new or improved technology, product, process, service, method, tool or solution. **Funding rate: 100 %**
- **IA (Innovation Action)** - primarily consisting of activities directly aiming at producing plans and arrangements or designs for new, altered or improved products, processes or services. For this purpose they may include prototyping, testing, demonstrating, piloting, large-scale product validation and market replication. **Funding rate: 70 %**
- **CSA (Coordination and Support Action)** - consisting primarily of accompanying measures such as standardisation, dissemination, awareness-raising and communication, networking, coordination or support services, policy dialogues and mutual learning exercises and studies, including design studies for new infrastructure and may also include complementary activities of strategic planning, networking and coordination between programmes in different countries **Funding rate: 100 %**

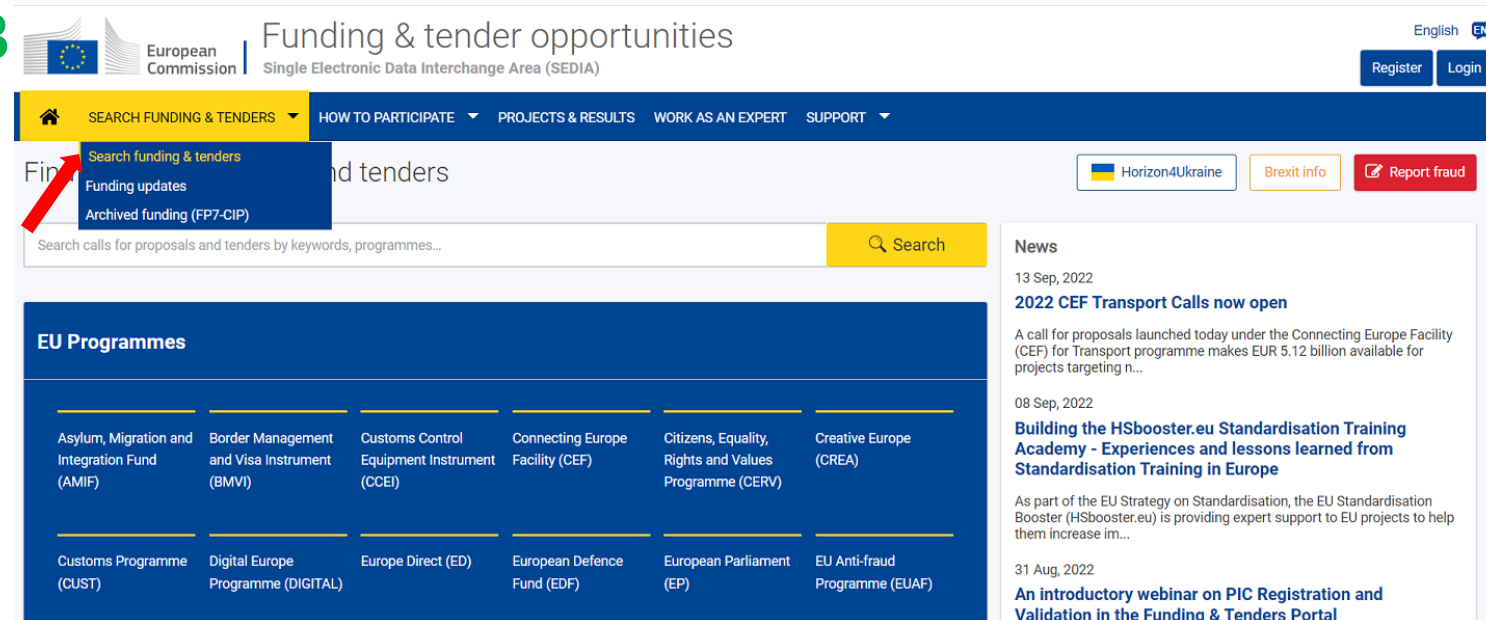
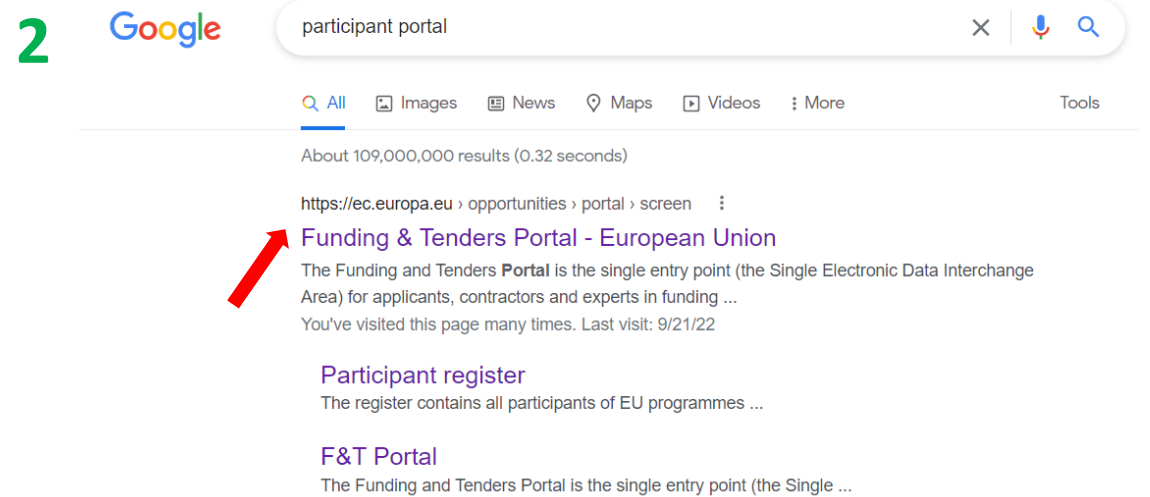
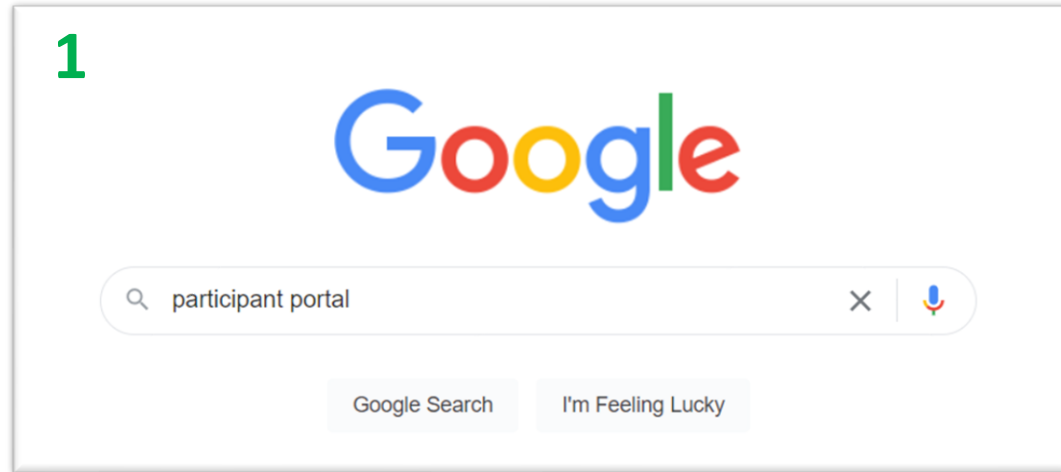
