The role of social partners in a just transition to a green economy

DATE AND TIME: 4 DECEMBER 2023, 11.00-12.30 CET IN ZOOM

SUMMARY:

The green transition seeks a carbon-neutral, sustainable society, moving from environmental harm to preservation.

Achieving this transition necessitates substantial economic adjustments, redirecting our approaches to energy generation, infrastructure development, and food production. At the same time, social rights must be prioritized throughout the process to create a transition that is also just, ensuring that the costs and benefits of the transition are equitably shared among all members of society.

Hence the realization of a green and just transition depends on the active involvement of various stakeholders, including social partners and the broader civil society. It is through this collaborative effort that the measures can be effectively promoted, and the inevitable compromises required can be balanced and negotiated through meaningful social dialogue.

Eurofound, the European Agency for the improvement of living and working conditions, has researched how social partners were involved in shaping the green and just transition in EU Member States (see report [here](#)). **Stavroula Demetriades** of Eurofound will present main findings of the report that are of relevance to partner countries of ETF.

There cannot be a green and just transition without developing the required human capital. Green skills are a priority topic in the work of the ETF. In a second part of the webinar, examples will be given from **ETF work in the field of green skills for a just transition**.

This GLAD* event will provide stimulating input and discussion for shaping a green and just transition – shedding specific light on social dialogue and green skills.
